

# BOOKING DETAILS

## **Activity - What do we throw away?**

Suitable for Age Range 7 - 11 years  
Minimum Time Suggested - 15 minutes

**Objective:** To see what types of materials make up our rubbish, and the proportion of each in our wheelie bins

**What you will need:** 4 mini wheeled bins each containing printed cards, mini photos showing 6 types of waste, 7 pie chart pieces and a 7 colour key. Use the chart on the reverse with the completed key for checking their answers

### **Directions**

- Give each group a piece of paper with a pie shape drawn on it.
- Ask them to think about a full rubbish bin like a big pie, cut into slices
- How big would each slice of be for each type of rubbish:
- organic matter (food and garden waste)
