### **OZBOX**

Also during the 6 weeks of Op Relentless OZBOX Boxing training sessions were held on a Monday night at Hilton Village Hall. The sessions, that were delivered by a Derby City PCSO also acted as training and taster sessions for 6 South Derbyshire Beat Officers and PCSO's who will receive the official Training in January. This will enable the scheme

to be rolled out across the District. The sessions attracted between 10-15 young people each week, and some of the attendees were problematic young people

### **Etwall Saturday Night Project**

After the success of the Friday Night Project at Granville School where over 100 young people attend every Friday Night, the Positive Activities Group have piloted a Similar scheme as Etwall Leisure Centre, with the First evening taking place as part of Op Relentless. Various sports, Dance and a chill out zone are provided for the young people, and around 20 attended the first session. A further SNP is scheduled for Dec and after Christmas it is hoped that they will run every other week.

### **Other initiatives to reduce Nuisance included:**

Op Edgware- police and neighbourhood wardens working together to tackle issues raised from weekly tasking meeting.

Op Pinamar - to combat ASB Hotspots and ASB Perps. - Extra SNT Team Operation targeting specific Safer Neighbourhood ASB issues and offenders
