TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

PARK ROAD AND LINTON HEATH, OVERSEAL

WHEN: From 20 February 2012 to 19 March 2012, between 18:30hrs and 00:00hrs, weekdays only.

WHERE: Park Road and Linton Heath, Overseal from their junctions with A444 Burton Road to points 25 metres from those junctions.

REASON: Carriageway resurfacing of A444 Burton Road.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES: Park Road: Occupation Road, Main Street / Bridge Street, Common Road / Church Street, Castle Road, A444 High Cross and vice versa and; Linton Heath: Main Street, Hillside Road / Linton Road, Burton Road, A444 High Cross and vice versa

Access will be maintained, whenever reasonably possible, on the affected length of road. The road will re-open as soon as the work is finished. This may be earlier than advertised.
