

Five Country Walks in South Derbyshire



Please be a 'green' tourist:

- **STAY** overnight rather than taking day visits.
- **GIVE** the car a rest and consider public transport.
- **SHOP** at village stores to benefit the local economy, and wherever possible buy local produce.

REMEMBER your destination is someone's home - respect the local way of life.

Public Transport

Wherever possible please use public transport rather than your car.

You can catch a bus to Melbourne, Repton or Ticknall for those walks. For the Milton and Foremark walk the nearest bus stop is at Repton (about 1 1/2 miles/2.4 kilometres away), while the nearest bus stop for the Anchor Church walk is at Swalkestone (about 2 miles/3.2 kilometres).

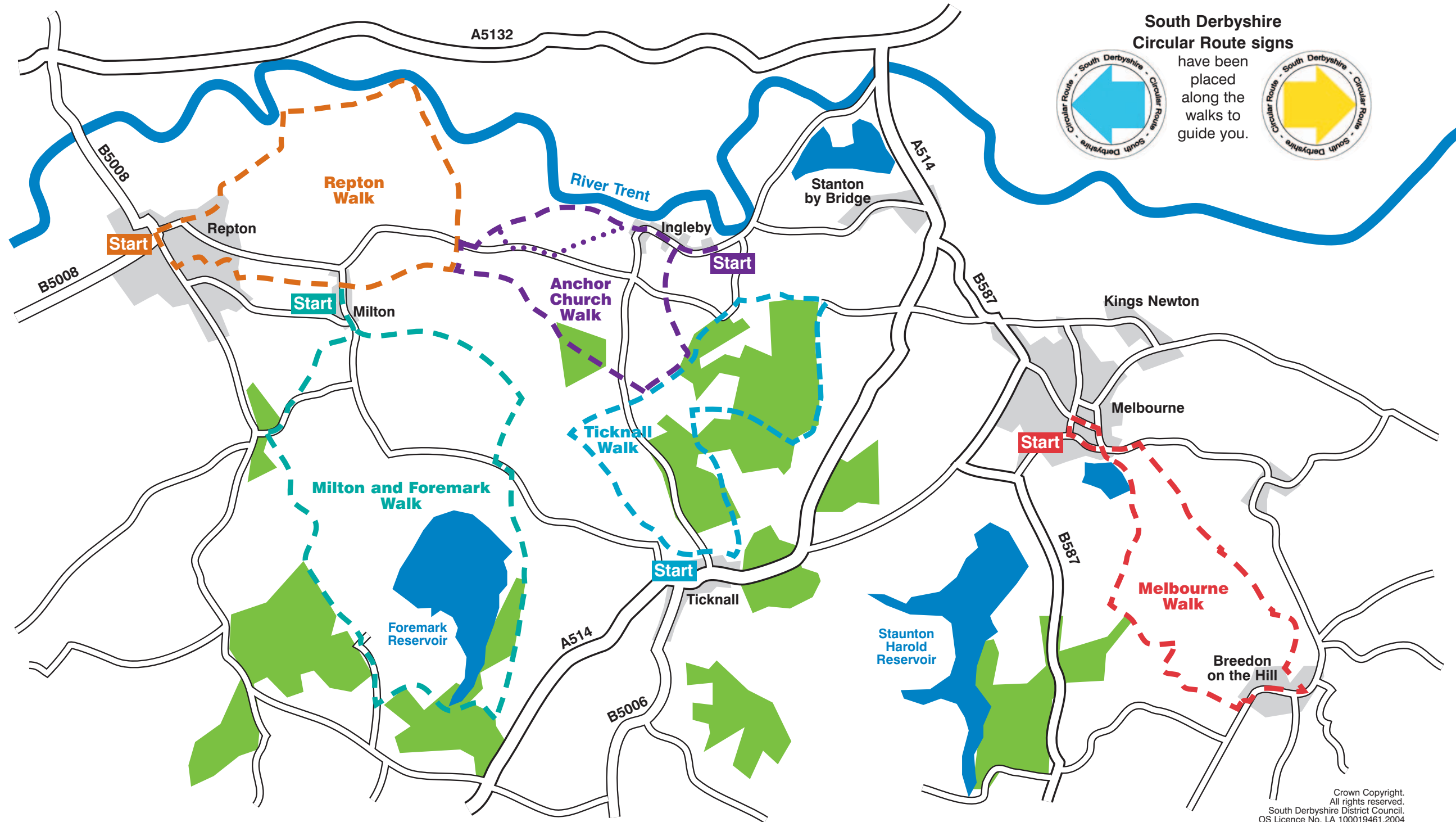
